The delegates and alternates voted to move the I.G.R.A. Convention to fall/winter from now on. Also the rodeo year will be changing from starting in November to a calendar year as well. These are some of the changes that did occur this weekend.

At the last A.G.R.A. meeting the membership voted to disburse \$20,000 to Charities and put \$5,000 in the CD. At the next two meeting's I will open the floor for nominations for 501 C-3 charities. If you wish to nominate a charity at either one of those meetings you must turn in their 501 C-3 paperwork and their budgets when you make your nomination to the Committee Chair. I have appointed Keith Carson as chair of that committee. This is a three-month process. At the third meeting we will invite speakers to come and speak to the membership about their charities and vote. Then in December we will present checks to the various charities that the membership voted on.

Also at the last meeting I appointed a new Audit Committee Chair since Diann Kimmel has moved to Texas. John King accepted that appointment.

I would also like to thank Diann for giving many years of hours of her time to A.G.R.A. Thank you Diann and I hope you enjoy Texas.

## Report from IGRA convention 2003

Convention 2003 was a huge success and I would like to thank our committee, delegates and alternates for all the hard work. There was nothing too controversial that came out of the committee meetings on Friday, however the IGRA rodeo year did change from the current November through October year to calendar year: January through December. This means that RRRR will be the first Rodeo of the year. In addition to this the current Trustee term ending October 31, 2003 will extend to December 31, 2003. AGRA will have to make appropriate bylaw changes to coincide with this IGRA change. There were two new rodeo association seated at the convention this year and a new Rodeo in Reno/Sparks Nevada. There were a myriad of bylaw, rule, royalty and dance changes made which will be reflected in the revised big book and rule book. I will highlight some of those at the next AGRA meeting. Although we put on a wonderful bid for finals 2005, the vote went to Dallas, Texas. I believe the idea of competing at the famous Mesquite arena was too appealing to the delegates and tipped the vote in favor of Texas. A big thank you to the Bid committee, Pussy LeHoot, and (very funny) Rawhide folks. Convention next year goes to Denver and in 2005 to Calgary with Finals Rodeo taking us to Omaha in 2004 and Dallas in 2005. 


