Don't forget! The 2009 World Gay Rodeo Finals will be October 23-25 in Albuquerque, New Mexico. The room block at the host hotel, Sheraton Albuquerque Uptown, is sold out. The Sheraton has worked out a deal with the Hilton Gardens down the street for the same \$85 per night room rate. The Sheraton is also making their shuttle service available to those staying at the Hilton. A special "party time" is planned for Saturday night at the Sheraton featuring "The Demented Divas in Totally Plowed" and Sandy Vee Anderson in a tribute to Dolly Parton. Miss Anderson is from Las Vegas Legends in Concert and has appeared on CMT, MTV and VH1.
