
Nominations for IGRA awards will also continue to be excepted at this months meet as well.

Trustee's Report

I was so pleased to be in town and attend the Membership Meeting on Sunday-May 16. I felt like I had been out of town "forever" attending meetings and conferences. Now, I will be attending the IGRA Board/Trustees Meetings in Oklahoma City on Friday-May 28 as well as attending the Great Plains Regional Rodeo during the weekend.

It is that time of year again to receive nominations for the International (IGRA) Awards that will be presented at the IGRA Annual Convention in November. In the May 16 Membership Meeting, nominations were received. Nominations will also be received in the June 6 Membership Meeting.

Award categories are:

### **International Award**

This award is to recognize those members of IGRA who have made contributions to IGRA worthy of special recognition. This contribution can be in any of the activities that IGRA encompasses. The Board of Directors selects the recipients of this award.

### Trustees' Award

This award is to recognize those contestants of IGRA who have exhibited excellence in the standards exemplified in the Code of Ethics and Sportsmanship. The Trustees select the recipients of this award.

### **Appreciation Award**

This award is for non-members of IGRA who have made significant contributions to the association and is a means of providing a formal "thank you". This award may be given by the Officers, Directors, Trustees, Committee Chairs, or any other official representatives of IGRA with the approval of the Board of Directors. IGRA will cover the cost of no more than two (2) awards per Member Association. (Note: All Appreciation Award nominees by an IGRA Member Association are automatic recipients, but IGRA only pays for two (2) of the awards; the local Association pays for the additional awards.)

Again, additional nominations will be received in the June 6 Membership Meeting, and appropriate voting will take place in the meeting.

The IGRA Annual Convention will be November 11-14, 2010 at Harrah's Casino in Reno, Nevada. AGRA is entitled to six (6) delegates and five (5) alternate delegates. Per AGRA Bylaws, the AGRA Trustee and President are automatic delegates. The four (4) people receiving the highest number of votes are delegates, and the five (5) people receiving the next highest number of votes are alternate delegates. Nominations for delegates were received in the May 16 Membership Meeting and will be received again in the June 6 Membership Meeting. Delegates and alternate delegates shall be elected by ballot vote of members present at the July Membership Meeting. Nominations received in the May 16 meeting are:

I encourage all members to consider attending the IGRA Annual Convention; it is a true learning experience, and all delegates/alternate delegates play a major role in approving IGRA Bylaws/Standing Rules/Rodeo Rules as well as electing IGRA Officers. If you are interested in attending, please ask another member to nominate you as a delegate. We want to have a full slate of delegates and alternate delegates representing AGRA. And, remember, contestants competing for an IGRA Royalty title and current IGRA Royalty can also be delegates/alternate delegates. All AGRA members are eligible for election as a delegate or alternate delegate.

The World Gay Rodeo Finals will be October 21-24, 2010 at the Mojave Crossing Event Center on the Fort Mojave Indian Reservation. The event center is right across the Colorado River from the Avi Resort & Casino in Laughlin, Nevada. The Avi is the host hotel for the finals rodeo. I encourage you to look at the information on the IGRA website and make your hotel reservations now while rooms are still available.


