
NOTE FROM THE PRESIDENT



HODEO EVENTS

Rough Stock events are considered to be the most dangerous of all rodeo events. At the same time they are the most exciting to watch. In the Gay Rodeo Association, the rough stock events are Bull Riding, Wild Cow riding, Bare Back Bronc Riding and Chute Dogging. All of these events require lots of practice, courage and very little brains (just kidding!).



The ride must last for 6 seconds. But, that is one long six veconds. Its a dangerous sport, exciting and fun. Wild Cow riding no! this is not something that the bull does! - remember, folks, this is GAY Rodeo we're talking about!) is basically the same as bull riding. Really, the only main difference is (you guessed it) they use a cow instead of a bull.

The scoring for both of these events is 50 points for the ride 25 points for the bull or wild cow, and 25 points for the rider. Extra points are awarded for spurring. There are 2 judges per event. If you are interested in finding out about any of these events, or any others, let me know. Play Safe and take care!

PRUTECTING YOURSELF FROM AIDS - PART 2 IN A SERIES

Knowing how to prevent yourself from getting AIDS is very important. Everyone must know the facts. This article will describe techniques you can use to reduce your chances of getting AIDS.

first, you must understand that you are at risk. YOU could get AID5: Anyone can be infected with the AIDS virus if they are exposed in the proper manner.

I want to stress that you <u>CANNOT</u> get AIDS through "casual contact". Casual contact is any contact with another person that is NOT sexually intimate. In other words, shaking hands with an AIDS patient is SAFE. So is sitting next to someone with AIDS, touching them, visiting with them, eating with them, etc.

AIDS CAN be spread through sexual intercourse. During sex, there is contact with another person's "body fluids." (Body fluids include seman, urine, feces, blood, vaginal secretions, etc.) These body fluids may contain the AIDS virus.

If that AIDS virus gets inside your body, you, too, could be infected. Therefore, protect yourself from your sexual partners and protect them from yourself. DO NOT give or receive any body fluids. In other words, DO NOT share body fluids.

The best way to protect yourself is by not having sex at all. Obviously, this doesn't appeal to many people. Therfore, the next best way to protect yourself is to ALWAYS wear a condom. Condoms are also called "rubbers" and "prophylactics." It doesn't matter what you call them, condoms can reduce your chances of getting AIDS.

In order for the comdom to work properly, you must follow several simple DO'S and DON'TS. These include:

1. ALWAYS put the condom on BEFORE you enter your partner.

ALWAYS be sure there is on air in the condom - not even on the tip..
 ALWAYS use WATER-BASES LUBRICANTS like KY JELLY, PRE-PAIR, FOR-

PLAY AND PROBE.

4. ALWAYS hold on to the base of the condom when you pull out of your partner. This prevents the condom from slipping off your penis and remaining inside your partner.

5. ALWAYS use a new condom each time you have sex.and the NEVERS

NEVER use spit (saliva) as a lubricant.

NEVER use oil-bases lubricants like Crisco, vaseline, or Baby Oil.

Uil-based lubricants can cause the latex rubber of the condom to

weaken. This weaking could cause the condom to tear during sex.

NEVER re-use an old condom - NEVER:

NEVER wait until part way through sex to put on your condom.

NEVER try to blow up a condom, to test it, and then use it.

This weakens the condom.

Remember, condoms can break or tear, possibly allowing you to be infected by the AIDS virus if the AIDS virus is present.

By using the condoms properly, you will cut down the possibility of infection. Follow the diagram, to be sure you put your condom on properly.

THE A-B-C'S OF PUTTING ON A CONDOM



Gently squeeze the tip of the condom with one hand, making sure there is no air in the tip. (This leaves room for the semen when you ejaculate [cum]. and forces out any air bubbles, which are a major reason condoms break.)

While you continue to squeeze the tip of the condom, forcing out any air, begin to unroll the condom down the length of your





... carefully unrolling it all the way down to the base of your penis to the hair.

There are other ways to protect yourself

DON'T use illegal intravenous (IV) drugs. If you do shoot up DON'T share dirty needles - DON'T share syringes - ever!
DON'T have sex with multiple partners. DON'T have sex with people
who have multiple partners. The more people you have sex with, the greater is your chance of getting AIDS.

3. DON'T have sex with someone who has AIDS.
DON'T have sex with someone who is likely to have AIDS. DDN'T have sex with someone who has tested positive with the AIDS anti-body test.

4. DUN'T have anal sex. Anal sex can cause tears in the body tissues making it easier for the AIDS virus to enter the body.

DON'T have oral sex. This activity can be dangerous, too.

The following columns list activities considered to be UNSAFE, SAFER, and MUCH SAFER. Keep these in mind and avoid those practices that may put you at risk.

UNSAFE






