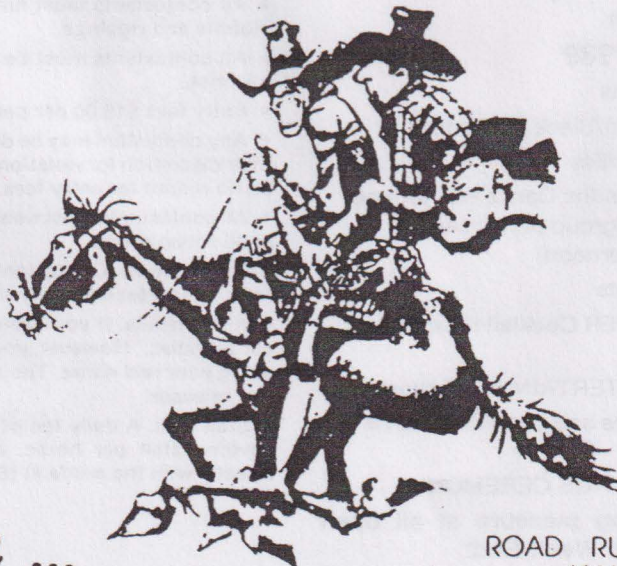

TICKET INFORMATION

\$10.00 per day — Saturday and Sunday (Free Admission to the Arena Grounds/Dance Hall on Friday only.) Children under 12 no charge.

CONTEST INFORMATION

- * IGRA sanctioned rodeo.
- * All applicable IGRA rules enforced.
- * All rodeo events are open to both men and women. Bull riding and bronc riding are the only exceptions. (Entrants must have previous experience).
- * All contestants must furnish or make arrangements for their own mounts and riggings.
- * All contestants must be at least 21 years of age and enter at their own risk.
- * Entry fees \$15.00 per person per event each day.
- * Any contestant may be disqualified by the rodeo officials/ judges at their discretion for violation of any IGRA rules. In such cases, there will be no refund for entry fees.
- * All contestants must wear their contestant I.D. Badge to be admitted to all rodeo events.
- * Team events. Contestants entering team events who do not have a team will be teamed with others upon your arrival.
- * Alias names. If you prefer to safeguard your anonymity, you may use an "alias." However, you are required to register and sign all forms using your real name. The alias will be used by the announcer and on any releases.
- * Stall fees. A daily fee of \$6.00 for an uncovered stall/\$10.00 for a covered stall per horse. All such arrangements should be made directly with the arena at (602) 237-3303.
