The DSRA Calendar is planned all the way through May and we have a lot of thing's coming up please keep your calendar's handy and we hope that more of you will come on out and show your support. If

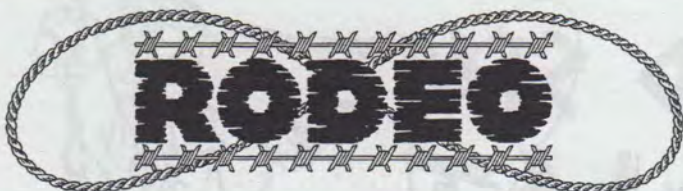

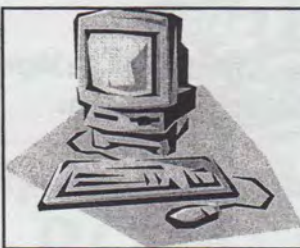

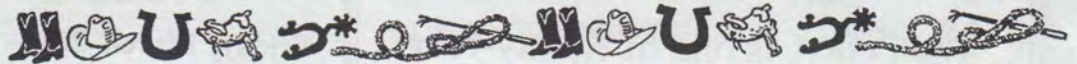
